

**OLDMANS TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE  
SPECIAL MEETING/BUDGET WORKSHOP  
JANUARY 20, 2011**

A special meeting/budget workshop of the Oldmans Township Committee was held on January 20, 2011. Mayor Miller called the meeting to order at 4:43PM. This meeting was held in compliance with the Sunshine Law. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present: William Miller, Harry Moore and George Bradford. Also present: James Hackett, CFO.

Jim-we received an agreement from Carneys Point for an extension of court services requiring 60 days notice.

Mr. Bradford made a motion for our mayor to sign the agreement with Carneys Point, Mr. Moore seconded and all agreed.

Jim reviewed the information that was received from the Mid Salem and Pilesgrove Courts. Mid Salem personnel has more experience and Pilesgrove has top notch courtroom facilities.

Harry-Pilesgrove.

George-feels should look at more than the cost. Trying to look at the whole operation-feels more comfortable with Mid Salem.

Bill asked if any of the other towns in mid Salem Court compare to us.

Jim-Quinton.

George tends to go with Mid Salem.

Harry feels comfortable with either one-still chooses Pilesgrove as it is a greater savings.

Jim feels percentages with Mid Salem would go down.

Mr. Bradford made a motion to go with the Mid Salem Court, Mr. Miller seconded.
